1. Competition Guidelines

- 1.1. Anglers must be a current financial member of either club
- 1.2. Catch and Scoring verification via "brag mat "photo with Angler's initials & Competition Code (Provided each day via SMS or Whats App to Anglers by Club Contact)
- 1.3. Boat Owners to submit angler scoresheets to club contacts by 2 pm @ Brooklyn Oval

2. Eligible Targeted Species

- 2.1. Only the following twelve species are eligible.
 - 2.1.1. Mahi Mahi (Dolphin Fish) Yellowtail Kingfish
 - 2.1.2. Flathead
 - 2.1.3. Mulloway (Jewfish)
 - 2.1.4. Snapper
 - 2.1.5. Whiting
 - 2.1.6. Bream
 - 2.1.7. Morwong
 - 2.1.8. Tailor
 - 2.1.9. Salmon
 - 2.1.10. Bonito
 - 2.1.11. Flounder

3. Points Scoring System

- 3.1. Anglers will receive <u>one point per species caught</u>. E.g., An Angler may catch 3 Flathead however they will only receive one point for the Flathead Species.
- 3.2. Anglers need to only record their <u>longest catch by species</u> on the scoresheet.
- 3.3. <u>Bonus points</u> are awarded by recorders based on longest fish caught by each species. e.g., 3 points for the longest flathead, 2 points to the second longest flathead, 1 point to the third longest.

4. Point Score / Awards

- 4.1. <u>Interclub trophy</u>: Awarded to the Club that records the highest *average* angler score. (Total club points divided by the number of Anglers)
- 4.2. Interclub Major Prize: (Dometic Cooler Supplied by BCF Valued at over \$100)
 - 4.2.1. Interclub Champion: Angler with the most points
- 4.3. Interclub Minor Prizes: (Various BCF supplied Tackle, Valued at over \$400 in total)

4.3.1. Best Boat:	Most points (Total Points divided by number of anglers)		
4.3.2. Best Angler:	Longest Targeted Species offshore or estuary		
4.3.3. Best Flathead:	Longest flathead, estuary or offshore		
4.3.4. Best Offshore Catch:	Longest fish offshore/reef fish		
4.3.5. Best Estuary Catch:	Longest fish caught in estuary (e.g.: Mulloway/Bream)		
4.3.6. Best Pelagic Catch:	Longest pelagic fish (Mahi Mahi/Kingfish/Bonito)		

Note: A fish can only be eligible for a prize in a single prize category.

4.4. Separate Club Prizes

- CHRSLFC Angler with most points.
- SBFC: Longest mystery fish prize.

5. Notes:

- 5.1 NSW Department of Primary Industries Recreational Fishing Rules and Regulations apply for species legal sizes, all bag and possession limits. No more than four (4) lines per boat.
- 5.2 Boat Skippers encouraged to Log on with Marine Rescue if heading offshore.
- 5.3 Where possible catch & release practices are encouraged.
- 5.4 Boat owners/Skippers are responsible for the safety of their boat and crew.
